# Advice for patients with fracture or dislocations

You have had an injury and the Emergency Department/Minor Injury Unit care provider has referred your case your case to the Orthopaedic Trauma Triage Clinic. Your records will be reviewed virtually by a Consultant Orthopaedic Surgeon within the next 72 hours. Depending on the X-Rays and notes you will receive either:

### An appointment to be seen in clinic

• If the Consultant Surgeon decides that you need further assessment or treatment you will be contracted (either by telephone or phone) with an appointment.

Or

### A telephone consultation

A specialist Trauma Nurse or Physiotherapist will call you to discuss your injury.

## **Key points**

- Please ensure the Emergency Department/ Minor Injury Unit reception staff have recorded your home and mobile telephone numbers
- Please answer calls from unknown numbers as this may be call from the hospital.
